SPORTS DAY 2016 FRIDAY 11 MARCH, 7.30AM – 12.55PM

Parents/carers are invited to attend our annual Sports Day, a very important day on the school calendar, to show their support and celebrate with us this whole school event. The major purpose of Sports Day is to have all students participating in some form of physical activity, the benefits of which are well-known.

To cater for the range of student interests, Sports Day will include both athletic events and team games. The athletic events will enable selection of our best athletes to represent the school at Santos Stadium later this term. Team games provide the opportunity to develop stronger working relationships between students in the same Home Group.

Our four Houses; Wright (Red), Thiele (Green), Lawson (Blue) and Gilmore (Yellow) are competing for the Dean Stringer Shield, won last year by Thiele. Students are asked to show wholehearted support for their House by dressing in their House

colour and participating in at least three events from the many activities available.

Sports Day commences at 7:30am and the Opening Ceremony will occur at approximately 8.45am when the Year 12 House Captains carry the 'Olympic Flame' and light the cauldron to officially begin events.

For safety reasons, parents are asked not to bring vehicles into the school grounds and should park in the area available near the roundabout, west of the school gymnasium. Sports Day is not an appropriate occasion for acquaintances or friends of students to visit the school and they will be asked to leave.

SPORTS DAY ATTENDANCE

ATTENDANCE IS COMPULSORY

The Year 12 SRC will be located outside of the Gym; they will be selling drinks, sweet food as well as supplying hairspray and face paint in house colours.

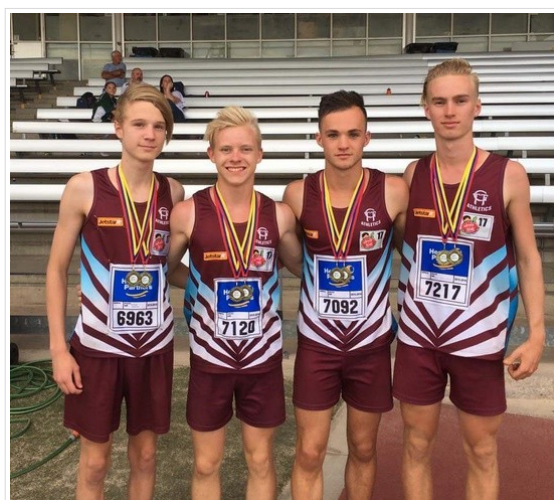

It gives me great pleasure to be the bearer of good news of a special student at Modbury High School. Eden Snaith in Yr 11 has worked extremely hard this summer to craft his talent and gain great achievement in the field of athletics.



During the weekend of 20 February 2016, Eden Snaith (1116) participated in the Little Athletics State Relay Championships (which took place at the athletics stadium in Adelaide) racing in two relay events under 17 boys 4x100m and 4x 200m. Eden and his team won both events and received gold medals. In the 200m they completed in a time of 1.37.18 mins but more importantly they broke the State Record for the 100m relay in a time of 46.26 seconds for the under 17 boys. This will go down in the State Record books at Adelaide, South Australia stadium.

Eden has trained hard twice a week or more, for the past few months, at his local Tea Tree Gully Athletics Club and is continually improving his times. He is a great asset to the club and we are very proud of his contributions and efforts which have come to fruition this year.
