“The Modbury High School Pedal Prix is a co-curricular program for Years 8-10 and can be taken as a Stage 1 SACE subject.”

We build, test and race powered three-wheeled recumbent bikes as part of the Australian International Pedal Prix super series which consists of 200 teams and more than 3000 riders from around the world.

The program has many benefits for students.

Students develop local, national and international friendships whilst hosting schools and teams. In 2017, we hosted a team from Indiana Institute of Technology. At each Murray Bridge race we host a team from Duncraig College in WA.

Students have an opportunity to make friends across all year levels and with members of the school community at training sessions which take place after school and lunchtime.

Students exercise creativity in bike design, presentations and problem solving.

Students improve physical fitness; develop confidence, independence, resilience and positive relationships with others.
