Bring Your Own Device

(BYOD)

To enrich the student's daily learning experience, it is essential that students bring their own laptop to School.

Laptops are used by students to create content, research topics and interact through online activities.

To provide the student at the school with the right tool to enhancing their learning experience the device should meet the minimum specifications as follows:

FORM FACTOR

- **Laptop device**

SCREEN SIZE

- **13.3" touch screen with Pen/stylus**

OPERATING SYSTEM

- **Microsoft Windows 10**

WIRELESS CAPABLE

- **5GHz 802.11n or higher specifications of 802.11AC or 802.11AX**
- Maybe advertised as '**DUAL BAND**' or '**GIGABIT Wireless capable**'

BATTERY LIFE

- **Advertised battery life of 8 hours use**

PROCESSOR or CPU

- **Intel i5**

MEMORY

- **8Gig RAM**

DISK DRIVE

- **256Gig SSD (Solid State Device)**

INSURANCE & WARRANTY

- **3-year Warranty (often included in price)**
- **Accidental loss and breakage insurance (highly recommended)**

SOFTWARE

- **Microsoft Office 365** is provided free by the Education Department to students

SECOND HAND LAPTOPS

- **Second hand laptops are not recommended** due to poor battery life and performance

The School has currently two suppliers that can offer a substantial price benefit and warranty which you may not get through the normal retailer. Most retailers only offer the normal 12 months warranty at best
