## Year 12 Term 1 Holiday Sessions and Expectations

Dear Parent/Caregiver and Year 12 student,

We would like to take the opportunity to provide information to all Year 12 students and their families regarding the upcoming school holiday sessions teachers will be running for certain subjects and some general expectations of the whole Year 12 cohort.

These holidays will provide the students time to take a breath after a busy start to their final year of schooling. As well, the holidays provide the opportunity for students to continue with and catch up on work in their subjects.

It is crucial students dedicate some time during the two weeks on each of their subjects – whether it is to continue critical work on their ongoing assignments for their subjects or getting feedback on their work through the drafting process. Those who have subjects with exams can take the opportunity to start their ongoing revision processes to consolidate their learning so far.
