Rationale

Modbury High School aims to uphold the highest standards for our staff and students. This standard is to ensure an adequate and timely first aid response in the event of an emergency and to minimise the risk of the transmission of infectious disease.

This standard applies to all department employees and those who engage in activities or services provided at a department site or service.

This standard does not apply to the health support needs of children and young people.

Procedure

As this is a mandated procedure with legal implications Modbury High School Staff will follow the department for Education's First Aid and Infection Control Standard.
